CLUB COMPETITION RULES

- 1.** The first name player/s of the schedule will be the CHALLENGERS, who will be responsible for (a) obtaining a marker for singles and (b) for offering two dates to the opponents within **SEVEN** days of the termination of the previous round. If the offered dates are not acceptable, the players involved will determine a date by mutual agreement.
- 2.** All games must be **COMPLETED** by the given date for each round. Should any difficulty arise concerning date of any match the Competition Secretary must be notified, whose decision will be final.
- 3.** For matches other than singles the players taking part in the first game shall constitute the **TEAM**. In any succeeding round, **ONE** player may be substituted and the substitute must not have played for any other team in that competition. **ALL** substitutes must be notified in writing to, and have the approval of the Competition Secretary. A substitute may not play in the **SKIP** position. The player who plays in the final shall be entitled to any award.

Failure to comply with any of the Rules may result in the forfeiture of the match.
